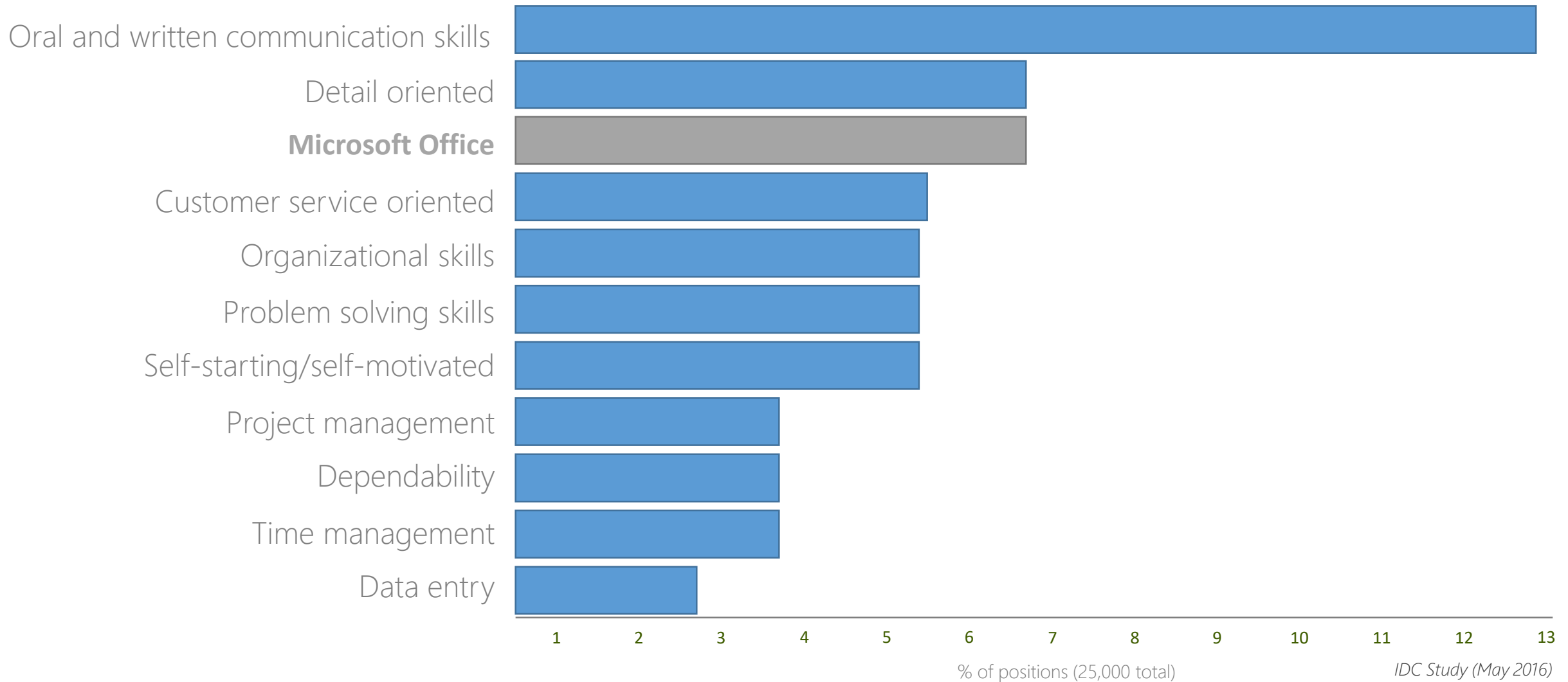

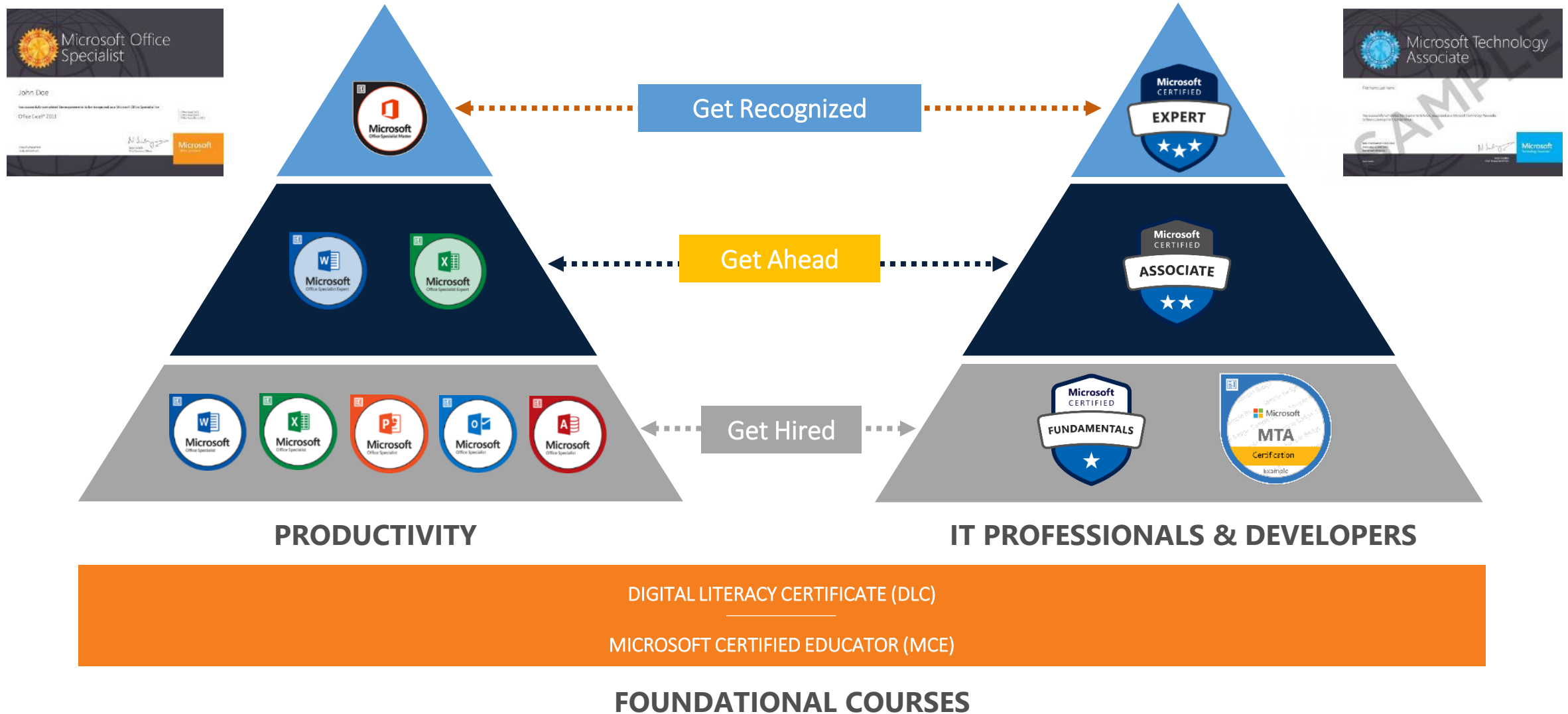
Top 10 Most Sought-After Employability Skills (IDC)

- To give all Business School students the opportunity to improve their competence with Microsoft products.
- To give all Business School students the opportunity to achieve certification which they can add to their CV

Embedding in the curriculum



- We include MOS certification for Excel within the curriculum of a core Year 1 module “Business Enterprise”.
- This module aims to enable all Business School students to develop an enterprising mindset, developing competencies and attributes to help them succeed in their future careers.
- We decided to make some of the learning time compulsory but the examination optional.



Implementation

- All students on the module had as part of a lecture an introduction to MOS, an explanation of the learning support and exam arrangements and instructions for registering. This was delivered by TU ITDS
- Students who requested access were added to a MS Teams site where all PPT training materials were available
- PC labs were provided in seminar time and sessions were facilitated by ITDS staff
- Mock Exams were provided in PC Labs
- Students who opted to sit the exam booked into specific slots in the PC Labs

Outcome



- 230 students registered on the Teams site
- Only 14 students took the excel test and 9 passed.
- We observed that engagement in the learning process was higher than the number reflected in the tests.
- Other test opportunities have been provided and students may take these up.
- We found as the MOS was not mandatory we struggled with engagement, students didn't understand the benefits.

- Across all Prodigy exams;
 - 262 sat exams
 - 185 passed exams
- These include different MOS exams, MTA, MCE, but also Adobe etc.
